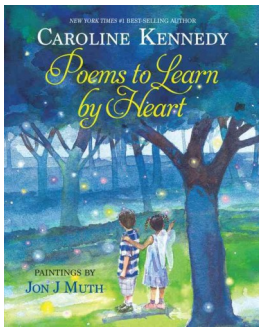


April is National Poetry Month
