

# Free Training for Nonprofits with Experienced Fundraisers

Participants will be able to blast through any psychological barriers by learning to build their case for funds, find out whom to ask and when, and empower new board members. The afternoon session will cover "making the ask" and creating a direct mail packet. Bring your current or draft fundraising letter for hands-on editing and review.
