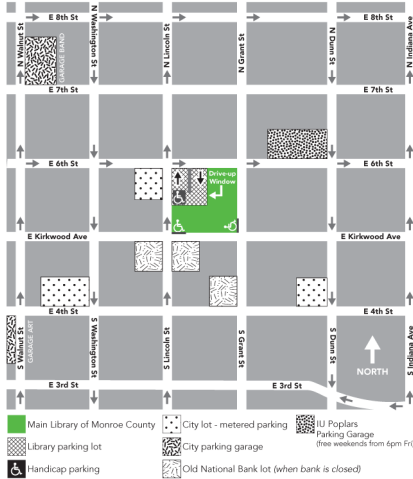


Parking Around the Library

The **library parking lot** provides free, 2-hour parking for library patrons. For quick drop-off and pickup, use the lay-by/loading zone in the lot.

Patrons planning to be at the library more than 2 hours must park elsewhere. Thank you for your cooperation.

All parking regulations strictly enforced



The **Drive-up window** off the library parking lot is open for holds' pickup all hours that the library is open. Next to the Drive-up window (and also next to the library entrance on Kirkwood) are 24-hour return slots.

On-street parking is available on most streets around the library where 2-hour parking is permitted. There are some exceptions. Please read signs carefully.
