

Library Van



What services are provided with the Library Van?

The Library Van provides library materials to residents of assisted living and senior living facilities. This service helps meet the needs of patrons who cannot access our library buildings or the Bookmobile. The Library offers Van Service to facilities both as lobby stops and deposit collections.

What is the difference between lobby stops and deposit collections?

Lobby stops are browsing collections brought biweekly to serve residents with limited mobility. Using rolling carts, Library staff set up a temporary mini-library in the lobby or activity room of facilities and check out materials directly to patrons.

Deposit collections can be separate from lobby stops or an additional service. Library staff deliver bags of books and other materials to sites biweekly or monthly. These facilities then establish their own method of distributing and using materials.

Are Library Van stops open to the general public?

Generally, no. Unlike Bookmobile stops, which are open to everyone, Library Van patrons typically must be residents, staff, or approved guests of the facilities we serve, in accordance with the policies of each specific site.

What materials are provided by the Library Van?

- Popular books (many in large print)
- Audiobooks on CD and Playaways
- DVDs
- Music CDs

All materials are regularly rotated to ensure variety. Library staff can obtain any circulating item in the Library's catalog for patrons.

What other outreach services does the Library provide?

Homebound Service TM is a personalized, monthly delivery of library materials to persons unable to use our Libraries due to prolonged illness, physical disability, or significant transportation problems.

Our Bookmobile TM offers service at housing developments and neighborhoods throughout the county. See our schedule TM for more information.

We also offer deposit collections to area Licensed Child Care Centers and larger Registered Child Care Ministries, and we provide library service to the Monroe County Correctional Center TM.
