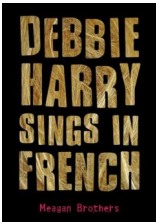
Becoming Billie Holiday

Jazz vocalist Billie Holiday looks back on her early years in this fictional memoir written in verse.



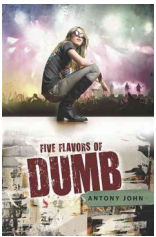
Debbie Harry Sings in French

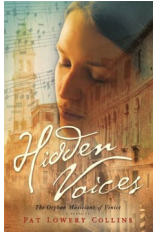
Five Flavors of Dumb

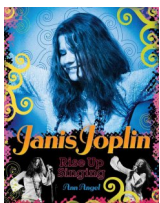
If I Stay

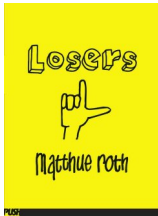
Janis Joplin: Rise Up Singing

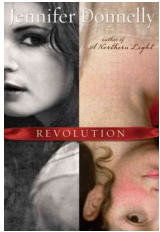
Punk Rock Etiquette: The Ultimate How-To Guide for Punk, Underground, DIY, and Indie Bands

Scott Pilgrim's Finest Hour

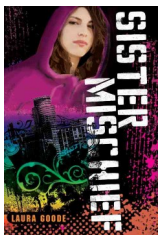

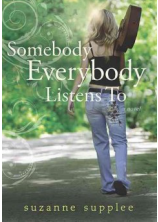

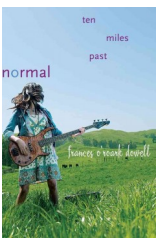
Sorta Like a Rock Star

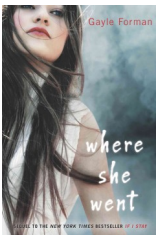
Virtuosity
