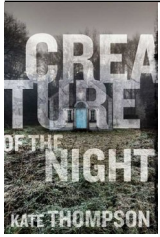

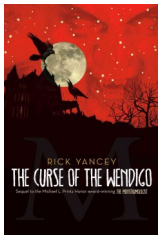


Creature of the Night

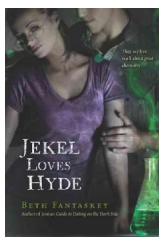
The Isle of Blood

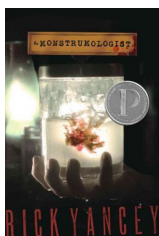


Jekel Loves Hyde

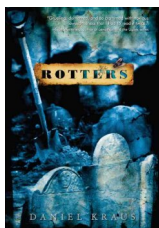
The Monstrumologist

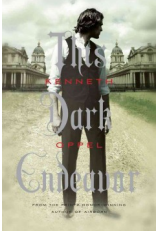


Rotters

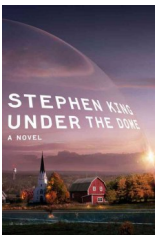
This Dark Endeavor

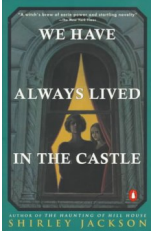


The Vanishing of Katharina Linden
